## BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Judith Reick Long (1935–87), an antiquarian book dealer, was educated at Indiana University. She and her husband, John Edgar Long, lived in Marietta, Georgia. She authored a biography of Indiana native Gene Stratton-Porter (1863–1924) entitled *Gene Stratton-Porter, Novelist and Naturalist*. The book was published by the Indiana Historical Society in 1990.
