Over its first five years, the Heritage Support Grants program offered grant opportunities and awarded more than \$2.6 million through 173 awards to 100 different organizations located in 57 Indiana counties. The funding education opportunities served 419 staff and volunteers with **40** workshops covering grant writing, building a case for support, annual funds and fundraising events.

Following its initial run, the Heritage Support Grants program was awarded the Association of Midwest Museum's (AMM) Best Practices Award in 2019. The program will continue thanks to another generous grant from Lilly Endowment Inc.


