BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCHES

Arthur Grant Littell was born on 30 October 1868 to John and Sarah Littell in Clark County, Indiana. In 1880, he was living with his family in Orange County, Indiana. On 1 December 1889 he married Belle Johnson in Clark County. By 1900, Littell was working as an undertaker in Wood Township. By 1910, he was selling dried goods and groceries, which is likely how he became associated with C.E. Bierly & Sons in Pekin, Washington County, just five miles from Borden in Clark County. Belle died 5 January 1914, and Arthur remarried Sarah F. McKinley on 4 January 1915 in Clark County. By 1920, he was working as an undertaker at Littell Funeral Home in Borden (New Providence), Indiana. Arthur Littell died on 11 January 1941.

Charles E. Bierly [Bierley, Byerly] was born on 13 April 1863 in Pekin, Washington County, Indiana, to David and Julia Bierly. He married Christena in 1888. They lived in Pierce, Washington County, Indiana in 1900 and New Albany, Floyd County in 1910. Charles Bierly died on 13 June 1925 in Kentucky.
