BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

In 2014 the Indiana Historical Society began the Indiana LGBT Collecting Initiative to collect, preserve, and make accessible materials that document the rich history, tradition, and culture of Indiana's LGBT communities. Part of the collecting initiative includes the Indianapolis/Central Indiana LGBT Oral History Project. During the time period of 2014–2017, interviews were conducted of individuals, couples and families from all walks of life in the Central Indiana area.

Ian Daniel was born in Boston, Massachusetts, but grew up in Washington and Vincennes, Indiana. Daniel is a producer, filmmaker, writer, and curator, as well as the co-host and executive producer of "Gaycation," alongside actress Ellen Page. Their Emmy-nominated series from Viceland explores LGBTQ issues, culture, and politics around the world. He currently resides in Brooklyn, New York.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The interview was transcribed from one video recorded interview. This manuscript was transcribed from a digitally recorded interview with Ian Daniel was conducted on 9 February 2017, at the home of Mark Lee of Indianapolis, Indiana. The interview was conducted by Mark Lee who was contracted by IHS for the project from 2014 to 2017. DLC was contracted by the IHS to transcribe the interview in September 2017. The interview, which includes the video recording and the transcript, is housed at the William H. Smith Memorial Library, Eugene and Marilyn Glick Indiana History Center. The video recorded interview is approximately a half hour long and is recorded on 1 DVD.
