HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Order of the Eastern Star is a fraternal organization affiliated with the Masons. It was first established by Freemason Rob Morris in 1850 and approved as an appendant body of the Masonic Fraternity in 1873. The order is open to both men and women and is dedicated to promoting charity and education through a focus on spiritual conviction and moral value. Many of the Order's practices are based on Biblical teachings, but the order is open to all faiths.
