HISTORICAL SKETCH

Terre Haute is located in Vigo County, Indiana, and is the county seat. Indiana State University, Saint Mary-of-the Woods College, Rose Hulman Institute of Technology and Ivy Tech Community College are all located there. The city is situated at a peak along the Wabash River. US Routes 40 and 41 intersect in Terre Haute. The area was the site of Fort Harrison, built in 1811 and used for the War of 1812. A battle took place there in 1812 and was the first land victory for the U.S. in the War of 1812.
