HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Indiana Bridge Company was established on 17 May 1886 by Theodore F. Rose and his associates. It originally built truss bridges and later made steel girders for the construction industry. The company moved from Indianapolis to Muncie on 12 November 1886. The Indiana Bridge Company produced steel for the U.S. war effort in both world wars. Over the years the company has changed management multiple times. It has been run by the following: the Kimbrough family (1888–1947), Taylor and Gaskin Inc. (1947–62), local investors (1963–71), an unnamed Alabama firm (1971–73), Debron (1973–78), and Bristol Steel (1978–82). Indiana Bridge, Inc. was placed on the Indiana Historical Society's Historic Business Register in 2005. The company continues to operate in Muncie, Indiana.
