

Be Heard: Asian Experiences in Indiana

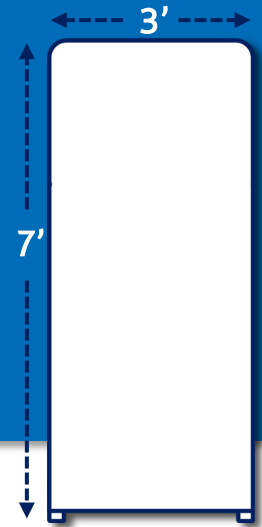

Ideas for use: Display local items that represent the Asian community in your area. Partner with a local organization to present a joint program.

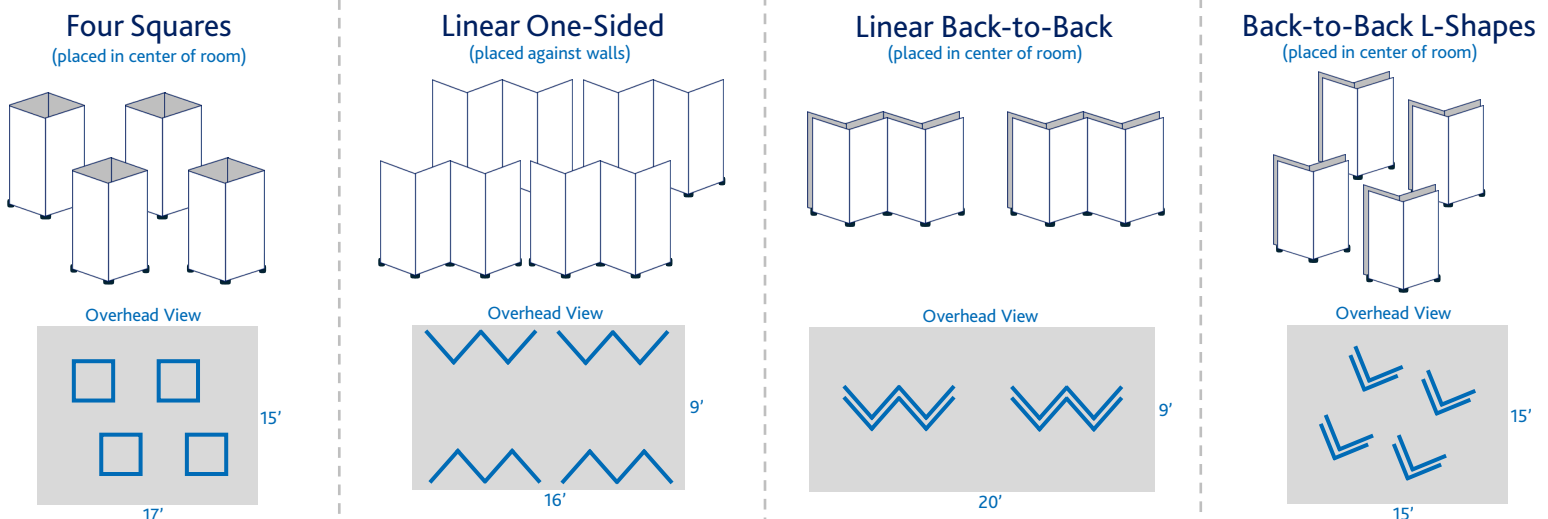
16 Panels

- ➔ Each panel is 3' wide x 7' high.
- ➔ The panels are printed fabric over metal frames.
- ➔ Panels are single sided (blank on reverse).
- ➔ The panels connect together magnetically.
- ➔ Requires approx. 200-250 sq. feet of floor space.



Sample Layouts

Typical setup is 4 sections (each containing 4 panels), but additional layout options and configurations are available. **Please Note:** Individual panels are not free-standing. At least two panels must be connected together to stand upright.
