#### Special Notes:

- **Exhibits** – Learners and sponsors may park in the lot across from Lecture Hall to load and unload exhibits only. IUPUI Campus Police will issue tickets to unauthorized parked cars left in permit lots. Exhibit removal will begin at approximately 1:30 p.m.
- **Performances** – Restrooms are available throughout the building for learners to change into costumes.
- **Documentaries** – Computers with projection screens are provided. Learners are responsible for ensuring compatibility with standard equipment. Documentaries may play from hard drives, DVDs, USB drives or from the internet. Learners are encouraged to bring multiple copies and formats of their project.

- All learners are encouraged to bring extra copies of their process paper and annotated bibliography for reference.
- Documentary, website and performance presentations are open to the public throughout the day. Please be respectful of others being judged and wait to enter the room until the current interview is complete.
- Papers will be available for public viewing at tables in the exhibit area during the public viewing time.
- Parking is available in the Vermont Street Parking Garage. Do not park in lots that require parking permits. IUPUI Campus Police will issue tickets to unauthorized parked cars in permit lots. Those in the parking garage should expect to pay \$9 to \$14 for the day.
