Floyd County: New Albany and Portland Ferry Company Records, 1862-1884

The New Albany and Portland Ferry Company was one of the many ferry companies along the Ohio River, transporting people and goods on steamboats. It was created by John Conner who came to New Albany, Indiana, in 1816 and bought a block of land from a competing ferry company. His son, Thomas, later joined him and by 1847 they owned many landings in both New Albany and Portland, Kentucky, directly across the river. It was later renamed the Portland and New Albany Ferry Company in 1881 and remained in business until 1891 when it was bought by a railroad company. The "golden age" of ferries lasted from 1835 to 1870, ending when bridges made the river accessible by trains.¹

The New Albany and Portland Ferry Company owned ferries near Upper Fifth Street in New Albany. Like other companies, they kept ledgers, cash books, and portage books. These records typically noted wharfage fees (taxes and payments for use of the landing area), supplies used, workers on the boats, and companies that provided services. The names listed below are crew members from a portage book dating from 1870 to 1872 and a cash book from 1872 to 1876. There were various roles on a steamboat or ferry that the men fulfilled during trips. The head of the boat was the captain, who typically owned the boat. The pilot was under the captain and was responsible for steering the ship. Under the pilot was the engineer who ran the boiler and engine and made sure the ship was working properly. The firemen, who worked for the engineer, stoked the boiler to create steam, while a striker managed the engines. The deckhands represented the biggest part of the crew, performing work as laborers, repairmen, and various other roles that are listed in the logbooks.²

Listed below are names from the Portage and Cash books of the New Albany and Portland Ferry Company. Among the alphabetized names in the cash book are lists of companies and their rendered services. The companies are useful in identifying the names of people who owned and operated various businesses in the area during the mid- to late-nineteenth century. The records below were compiled by John Conner's great-granddaughter, Virginia Lee Bennett, and are now available at the Indiana Historical Society's William Henry Smith

Memorial Library, along with other ledgers, cash books, and portage books from the New Albany and Portland Ferry Company collection. There are no page numbers listed with the names on the transcribed list below, but most show up more than once and can be found on multiple pages.³
