### BACKGROUND

- Made possible by Lilly Endowment Inc grant
- \$2.5 million in re-grants to Indiana historical organizations
- Education is essential
  - Fundraising workshops
  - Coaching
  - Review panel spots for Local History Partners



### HERITAGE SUPPORT GRANTS

### Mini Grants

- \$500 \$4,999
- No cash match required
- 11 month grant cycle
- One-part process


### **Project Grants**

- \$5,000 \$50,000
- 15% cash match
- 100% board support
- 12 month grant cycle
- Two-part process









### ELIGIBILITY

- Be incorporated in the State of Indiana as 501(c)3 nonprofit corporation\*
- Reflect history as significant component of organizational mission and/or propose history-focused project
  - Interpret, present or otherwise disseminate a historical narrative or information
- Have an annual budget of less than \$300,000



\*An organization that operates under a larger parent organization is eligible only through a "friends group"

### FRIENDS GROUP

- Required to supply a letter from their parent organization confirming
  - Parent organization supports the project and application for grant funding
  - Representative of the friends group is on the grant project team
  - HSG funds will be held and disbursed by the friends group

### COACHES

- Assigned after online grant portal registration

- NOT involved with grant review panels
- Provide support throughout project implementation and reporting



### PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

- Projects must adhere to or help organization meet accepted professional standards
- Organization expected to have or obtain necessary professional expertise to carry out proposed project
- Refer to set standards and guidelines and/or contact your coach if you need assistance



\*Please note that while Local History Services coaches are available to assist organizations throughout the grant application process, they are not part of the grant selection process. All grant applications will be evaluated by an external committee. The use of an LHS coach does not guarantee funding.





### Optional, but highly recommended

- Supporting documents
- Up to 2 letters of support



#### ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

The following attachments are Required for all applications:

- Annual operating budget (current fiscal year)
- · Project budget (using the provided Budget Template)
- · Board list with affiliations
- Confirmation of 501(c)(3) status (tax exempt determination letter)
- · Any project-specific documents requested by IHS

Additional supporting documents such as contractor estimates, before photos, resumes or job descriptions, historic structures reports, etc., are highly recommended.

Organizations may provide up to 2 letters of support.

Friends group applications are required to supply a letter from their parent organization confirming the following:

- The parent organization supports the project and application for grant funding.
- A representative of the friends group is on the grant project team.
- HSG funds will be held and disbursed by the friends group.


