

**The “Jefferson Chronicles”: Statewide Articles in
the *Indianapolis Daily Sentinel*, 1869–1872**

As an extension of his article “The ‘Jefferson Chronicles’: Statewide Articles from a Nineteenth-Century Indiana Newspaper Correspondent,” in the fall/winter 2008 issue of *THG: Connections*, George C. Hibben compiled an index of all the newspaper articles (usually referred to as “letters”) attributed to “Jefferson,” the *nom de plume* of his ancestor Rev. William W. Hibben. Part 1 includes this list of Rev. Hibben’s submissions published between September 11, 1869, and May 11, 1872, in the *Indianapolis Daily Sentinel*. The publication dates, categories or types of letters, and short descriptions of the articles are provided for each entry. A key at the beginning of the index briefly explains the category system created by George Hibben and applied to each article. The information presented in Part 1 has been spot-checked only against the original newspaper articles. Therefore, further examination of the original articles is advised to ensure the accuracy of any particular data.

Part 2 is a name database generated from a sample of the articles indexed in Part 1, as an example of what can be found in mid- to late-nineteenth-century newspaper articles from roving correspondents such as Rev. Hibben. It provides the names of people recorded by Rev. Hibben within particular communities, along with the article titles in which the names were found and the dates they were published. The sample of twenty-three articles in Part 2 includes a variety of towns and counties across Indiana and covers an array of dates throughout the thirty-three months in which Rev. Hibben’s articles were published. The database is alphabetized by the last name of each person listed. Each name has been transcribed as it appears in the article. Titles, such as “Mr.,” “Rev.,” and “Dr.,” have been included if both a first name is missing and a title or gender designation is given in the article. If Rev. Hibben provided both a title and a first name that clearly designates gender, the title has not been included in the database. Editorial additions are indicated in brackets.
