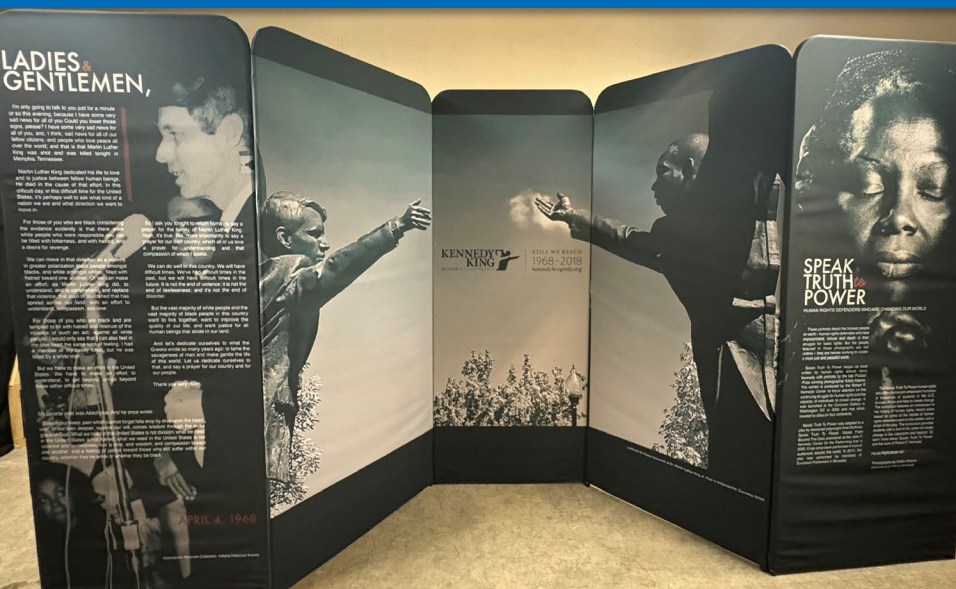


Local Speech, Global Reach



This exhibit explores the impact of Kennedy's words and King's legacy, while also looking at the Civil Rights Movement in Indianapolis. The second major element of the exhibit showcases themes brought out in Kennedy's speech and King's civil rights work by exploring the lives of several human rights defenders working around the globe.

Ideas for use: Showcase items related to the Civil Rights Movement or partner with a local human rights group while this exhibit is on display.

8 Panels

- ➔ Each panel is 3' wide x 7' high.
- ➔ The panels are printed fabric over metal frames.
- ➔ This exhibit is double-sided (images on both sides).
- ➔ The panels connect together magnetically.
- ➔ Requires approx. 180-200 sq. feet of floor space.

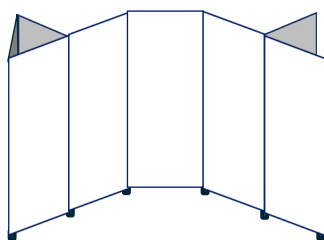


Sample Layout

Typical setup is one section, but additional layout options and configurations are available.

Please Note: Individual panels are not free-standing. At least two panels must be connected together to stand upright.
