Mayfield and Sanders Family Materials, Owen County Cemetery Notebook, 1754–1936

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The Mayfield and Sanders Family Materials is a collection of correspondence, diaries, and photographs, along with cemetery and church records from Monroe and Owen Counties. The Mayfield and Sanders families were linked together by the marriage of Julia Mayfield to Adoniram Judson Sanders, a neighbor of the Mayfields at their home in Richland Township, Monroe County, Indiana, near Bloomington. They were married on April 25, 1867, and lived in Green and Monroe Counties as well as in Gosport, Owen County, near the cemeteries listed below.¹

Ura Sanders, a daughter of Julia and Adoniram, compiled a cemetery notebook containing transcribed grave markers in Monroe and Owen County cemeteries. While there are unrelated families within the records, many of the surnames belong to cousins or spouses of the Mayfield and Sanders families or are seen in other parts of the collection. The cemeteries listed below are all located within twenty minutes of each other in either Gosport, Spencer, or Freeman in Owen County and contain some overlapping names and familial relations between them.²

The information transcribed below includes names, birthdates, and death dates as they appear within the notebook. However, distinctions between birth and death dates are unclear in some cases. Also included are notes that may be used for identification, such as familial relations, age at death, and military service. Notations indicating service in the Revolutionary War, Civil War, and War of 1812 are located by the veterans' names. Although some details about the cemeteries have been omitted here, the full records are available in the original collection at the Indiana Historical Society. Approximate locations of the cemeteries have been provided, but coordinates can be found on the Indiana State Historic Architectural and Archaeological Research Database (SHAARD) cemetery registry.³
