PRIMARY SOURCE ANALYSIS



GROUP PROGRAM

- Included with group admission reservation
- Intended for students grades K-5

Students in grades K-5 can participate in a rotation where they have hands-on experience with primary sources documents related to history, civics, literature, economics, and religion. Students will examine primary source documents and explore what these primary sources can tell us about the past.



GROUP WORKSHOP

- Additional \$3.50 per student with group admission reservation
- Intended for students grades 6-12
- Max capacity of 60 students

DESCRIPTION: This 45-minute workshop experience allows students in grades 6-12 to explore and interact with historical documents from the Remnant Trust Collection. Educators can choose to explore history, economics, philosophy/literature, civics, or religion; documents will be selected along those themes. Students will engage in a discussion about the selected documents and then have the opportunity to explore and analyze the documents up close with the help of museum staff.

AVAILABILITY: Workshop will be available for booking on Thursdays only during August-May.

THEME SELECTION: Educators will select **one** theme of the five. Documents will be selected by the IHS team based upon suitability to the theme and availability.
