Agnes Gaff Fry [Frey] was born in 1866 to William and Clara Fry in Indiana. She had four sisters. Around 1888, she won a gold medal/badge in a roller skating competition. Agnes Fry married Benjamin Prather on 5 February 1890 in Marion County, Indiana. They had two children. She lived in Chicago in 1935, and then later lived with her daughter's family in New York in 1940.
