Bruner was a schoolteacher and farmer in Paoli (Orange County), Indiana; editor of the *Paoli Republican* (ca. 1897-1909); and an Indiana food and drug inspector (1907-1933).

The collection consists of notebooks with lesson plans and other writings relating to schoolteaching (1875-79); and Bruner's farm account books (1879-98).
