**BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Alpha Rho Latreian was organized 4 December, 1950. It was affiliated with Indiana Federation of Clubs and General Federation of Women’s Clubs. The object of the organization was to obtain a better knowledge of the community for the purpose of rendering service, and to cooperate in the advancements of the ideals and projects of the General Federation of Women’s Clubs as well as in the State and Seventh District Federation. Meetings were held the first Tuesday of each month, September through May. They usually included a speaker to discuss a specific topic of interest, but some meetings were elections for new officers, or dinners during the holidays or for other special occasions.

Collection consists of two manuscript folders. The first folder is mainly photocopied pages from a scrapbook about the Alpha Rho Latreian group in 1955 and 1956. It includes newspaper clippings, a certificate of appreciation from the March of Dimes, and a booklet of members. The other folder contains a three-page handwritten history of the women’s auxiliary group Athenaeum Turners.
