## HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Association for Loan Free Education (ALFE) was established in Marion County in January 1972 to provide “counseling service designed to help individuals successfully pursue...education after high school.” Founders included James Harvey Ricketts, Sr., Rosevelt Colvin, Jr., and Reverend Stanley S. Thomas. The organization focuses on students from low-income families and first-generation college students. As of 2001, the organization was still in operation.
