## BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Wilbur Volosco Bell (May 15, 1884-September 8, 1976) was born in Niles Township, Delaware County, Indiana to David M. Bell and Lucinda Cemer Bell. He was one of five children and was educated at Albany schools and then graduated from Indiana University in 1908. He worked as an educator and administrator, serving as principal of Albany High School and Mooreland High School. After leaving the education field, he was a farmer until he retired in 1966. Bell was active in the Albany United Methodist Church, the Anthony Lodge 171 F&AM and was also an artist and member of the Muncie Artists Guild.

Wilbur Bell married Nettie Lillian Bartlett on June 29<sup>th</sup>, 1909. Nettie (November 25, 1884-November 25, 1954) was the daughter of Warner Bartlett and Katherine Whitehair. She had three siblings and grew up in the Albany, Indiana area. Nettie was a member of the Pollyanna Circle and the Reticule Club. She and Wilbur had two daughters, Mary Louise and Harriet Elizabeth.

Harriet Elizabeth Bell (December 26, 1911-August 22, 2002) graduated from Albany High School, Indiana University, and she earned her nursing certificate from City Hospital in Indianapolis (now known as Eskenazi Health). During World War II, she enlisted and served with the Army Nurse Corps from 1944 to 1946. She served in Europe with the 116<sup>th</sup> Evacuation Hospital in France and Germany and was part of the unit that provided medical assistance to over 2,000 people who had been imprisoned at the Dachau concentration camp. After her wartime service, she returned to the Albany area to continue her nursing career until her retirement in 1971. She enjoyed traveling internationally and spent time with her family in Silverthorne, Colorado.

Mary Louise Bell Stone (April 8, 1910-May 31, 2000) graduated Albany High School and attended Indiana University with her sister, Harriet. She married Robert Verne "Ty" Stone on August 31<sup>st</sup>, 1934. The couple had three children, Elizabeth Ann, Sara, and Thomas. While raising her children and helping on the family farm, Mary also went back to school to finish her bachelor's degree at Ball State University. She then followed in her father, Wilbur's, footsteps as a teacher in the Albany schools.

Robert Verne "Ty" Stone (September 2, 1908-September 25, 1980) was the son of George E. Stone and Gustina Luella Mann Stone. He was educated at Albany Schools and attended DePauw University. Aside from four years spent with his wife, Mary, working at the Western Center/Morganza hospital and school in Pennsylvania, Ty Stone was a lifelong Albany resident. He was employed by Warner Gear for thirty-three years, where he worked as a supervisor until his retirement in 1972. He and Mary were members of Albany United Methodist Church.

Elizabeth Ann Stone Baldwin (March 28, 1937- ) grew up in Albany with her two siblings. She attended Albany schools and Indiana University, where she earned a B.S. in business. She has one son, Michael Haydon Miller from her first marriage to Donald Haydon Miller. In 1980, she married Brian Baldwin (January 24, 1931-May 25, 2020), entrepreneur and co-founder of Baxa Corporation. The couple made their permanent home in Colorado but traveled extensively for both business and pleasure.

Sara Lucinda Stone (May 12, 1943-August 8, 2011) grew up in Albany with her two siblings. She attended Albany schools and Indiana University, where she earned a B.A. in history and geography. She furthered her education in history and secondary social studies at Antioch College, where she graduated in 1974. Sara settled in Arlington, Virginia, where she worked as an Archivist for the National Archives and Records Administration and the National Park Service. Sara was interested in fine arts and print culture, as a collector, patron, and museum member.

Thomas David Stone (April 17, 1945-August 8, 2018) grew up in Albany with his two siblings. He attended Albany schools and earned a B.S. in business from Indiana University. After college, he worked as a teacher in Eaton, Indiana before moving to Atlanta, Georgia. He worked for Delta Airlines for twenty-six years as the Director of Stockholder Relations. He was married to Patricia Rairden Stone and they had three children, Anijka, Kristen, and Robert.

Michael Haydon Miller (December 17, 1960- ) was born in Indianapolis, the son of Donald Haydon Miller and Elizabeth Ann Stone Baldwin. He grew up in Evanston, Illinois and graduated from the University of Denver in 1985. Miller formerly worked in broadcasting and is an entrepreneur. He married Kathryn Lynn Hoge on October 22, 1994 and has two children, Isaac and Hayden. A deep interest in family history and genealogy led him to become a lifetime member of the Society of Indiana Pioneers and the Indiana Historical Society.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection contains papers, photographs, and compiled genealogies for the Bell and Stone families, who were brought together by the marriage of Mary Louise Bell Stone and Robert Verne “Ty” Stone. The collection is separated into series by family/family member and is arranged chronologically.

The first two series of the collection are for items belonging to the Bell and Stone extended families and ancestors, which includes Nettie Bartlett’s family, Wilbur Volosco Bell’s parents, David M. Bell and Lucinda Cemer Bell, along with his siblings. On the Stone side, this includes Ty Stone’s parents, George E. Stone and Gustina Mann Stone, as well as his siblings Harry, George, Helen, and Paul, in addition to some members of the Mann and Lockhart families. There is a photo album in the Stone and Mann family papers that does not have any identification by the creator but appears to include members of the Stone and Mann families in addition to showing glimpses into life in the Albany, Indiana area during the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. Also found in this part of the collection are genealogies for the Whitehair [Bartlett] and Bell families. Series 3 contains materials belonging to Harriet E. Bell, including the correspondence she sent home to her parents and sister during her time serving in World War II where she describes her daily routine, living conditions, and her tourist experiences when she had leave. Of particular interest is a scrapbook that she kept during this time that contains photographs of her and her fellow servicemembers, maps, brochures, ticket stubs, and other ephemera she collected. Series 4 has items belonging to Robert Verne “Ty” Stone, his wife Mary Louise Bell Stone, and their family of five, as well as a compiled genealogy for both Ty and Mary’s families. Series 5 through Series 8 contain items belonging to Ty and Mary’s three children, Ann, Sara, and Thomas, as well as their grandson, Michael. The final series of this collection, Series 9, contains printed items, photographs, and documents relating generally to the history of Albany, Indiana and surrounding areas.
