Bernie Herman worked as a broadcaster for NBC affiliate radio station WIRE in Indianapolis in the 1950s. He hosted a late-night show called "Nitebeat" that featured popular contemporary music. His was the first to broadcast from WIRE's new call letters on 27 October 1950.
