## **HISTORICAL SKETCH**

The Beta Beta Latreian Club was an Indianapolis social and service organization for senior women whose object was "to bring all members into work for the mutual advancement of the individual and the community; and for social enjoyment." The club held an annual "Taster's Luncheon" and fashion show fundraiser where they compiled cookbooks of the recipes served as well as sold various homemade items. The proceeds were donated to local and national organizations. The group also organized field trips and activities for its members including sewing, canning, and cooking workshops hosted in the home of various club members. The materials from this collection belonged to Helen Kleis (1923–2010), an active member of the club, who served as its Publicity Chairman.
