BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Hilda Bloom (née Monty) was born 23 April 1849 in Rockville Township, Illinois, to Henry Sterling Bloom and Elizabeth Ann Kearns. In 1870, she was listed in the U.S. Federal Census as a teacher and living with her parents and 10 siblings.

Hilda married Joseph Monty on 29 January 1874 in Kankakee, Illinois. By 1880, the couple lived in Union Township, Indiana, where Joseph was a farmer and Hilda kept house. Joseph died on 17 January 1917.

By 1920, Hilda had returned to Kankakee, Illinois where she lived with three of her sisters: Edith, Inez, and Osburga. Hilda died on 4 March 1940 in Goodland, Indiana.
