HISTORICAL SKETCH

William N. Bullitt (1808-1867) was born in Louisville, Kentucky. By 1850 he was living in Bono Township, Lawrence County, Indiana.

William J. Throckmorton (1813-1855) was born in Virginia. Like Bullitt, he too was living in Bono Township in 1850.

The original merchandising store and grist mill in Lawrenceport was started in 1837 by S. P. Moore. Bullitt and Throckmorton acquired the businesses around 1847, and in 1853 they rebuilt the mill. S. B. Barnes purchased the business from Bullitt and Throckmorton, and he later sold to Henry Harmyer.
