BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Charles A. Jines, son of John W. and Minnie Jines, was born in Madison, Indiana on January 21, 1893. At 25 years-old, Charles joined the United States Army as part of the Chauffeur, Flying School Detachment. On September 22, 1912 Charles married Goldie Klingensmith, but was divorced by the 1920 census. On May 5, 1919 Charles was honorably discharged by the army and returned to his parents' home. Upon entering the army, Charles was a mechanic, and continued this as an upfitter in the automobile industry following his discharge. Not long after, he began working as a taxicab driver. Sometime between 1930 and 1940, Charles married Bessie M.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

In this collection is Charles A. Jines' honorable discharge paper from the United States Army dated May 5, 1919. The paper lists Charles' company, enlistment date and age, birth location, physical description, and circumstances of discharge. Charles was discharged from Fort Benjamin Harrison in Indiana, and the document is signed by his commanding officer, Lieutenant Colonel Blake. There is a stamp issuing a hunting, fishing, and trapping license to Jines on June 28, 1928, and another stamp marking the official received for record from Recorder of Marion County on March 3, 1965.
