## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Charles Lloyd Cavanaugh (October 11, 1907-December 27, 2000) was the son of grocer John L. Cavanaugh and Lavenia Sisk Cavanaugh of State Line, Indiana. He had one brother, Earl. Charles spent his career as a public school teacher, administrator, and coach in Warren County, Indiana, at Rainsville School, Independence School, and Pine Village High School. He was married three times, first to Opal Roderick (1935), then Alice Clapp Roderick (1950), and finally to Dorothy Harmon (1993).
