**BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Bundy was a farmer in Amboy and Converse (Miami County), Indiana; and served with the American Friends Service Committee in France (1919–20).

**SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

The papers are composed of Bundy's diary and letters to his family, written in France where he was involved in relief operations in the war front areas after World War I; his farm account books (1909–53); Miami County tax receipts and land deeds (1850–1900); and a Sunday school record book for the Society of Friends in Russiaville and West Middleton, Howard County, Indiana. (1880–82).
