BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

In 2014 the Indiana Historical Society began the Indiana LGBTQ Collecting Initiative to collect, preserve, and make accessible materials that document the rich history, tradition, and culture of Indiana's LGBTQ communities. Part of the collecting initiative includes the Indianapolis/Central Indiana LGBTQ Oral History Project. During the time period of 2014–2018, interviews were conducted of individuals, couples, and families from all walks of life in the Central Indiana area.

Daniel Noel was born ca. 1974 in Seymour, Indiana. He was raised there in a conservative, very religious, Lutheran family. During high school, he was a food service worker in a hospital. He earned a degree in health and nutrition at Indiana University in Bloomington. He began working at Columbus Regional Hospital in Columbus, Indiana, in 1999, eventually becoming a registered nurse there. He was part of PFLAG (Parents and Friends of Lesbians and Gays) for many years before switching to a Pride Alliance chapter. He was involved with the first Pride event in Columbus, Indiana, on 14 April 2018.
