BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

David Nelson Crutchfield (1830–1911) was born in Indiana and resided in Shelby and Johnson counties. In August, 1862, he enlisted as a private in Company I of the 70th Indiana Regiment and was mustered out in June, 1865. Crutchfield and his wife, Sarah, left Indiana in the later 1870s and moved first to Nebraska and later California.
