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HISTORICAL SKETCH

Niles township is located at the northeastern corner of Delaware County, Indiana. European settlers claimed half of the land in Section 32 by 1831. The rest was claimed subsequent to 1836. According to John S. Ellis' history of Delaware County, William and John Battereal settled in Section 32 of Niles Township in 1831.
