BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Doctor Celia S. McDonald (fl. 1880s–1910s) was from Kokomo, Howard County, Indiana. In the early 1900s, she attended the Physio-Medical College of Indiana in Indianapolis. After matriculating, she returned to Kokomo and set up a practice. In August 1914, she married J. C. Shean.
