## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Dr. Randy Long is the son of Clarence W. Long, who worked for the accounting firm Ernst and Whinney (now Ernst & Young). Clarence Long and his wife Mildred were on the planning committee for "A Tribute to the Bowen Years, 1973–1981."

The town of Oxford was the first town laid out in Benton County, Indiana, in 1843. The home in the pictures was built in 1882 by banker Zimri Dwiggin and purchased by Joseph Heath in 1895.
