HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Dynes-Pohlman Lumber Company was established ca. 1911 on East 28th Street and the Monon Rail Road in Indianapolis, Indiana. The company was founded by the company's president, Eldon L. Dynes, and its secretary and treasurer, Gustave E. Pohlman. The lumber yard and planing mill boasted itself as the "Most modern planing mill in the state."

Eldon Dynes had previously owned his own lumber company, Dynes Lumber and Coal Company, with Robert E. Morrison. This company was incorporated on 19 December 1901.
