BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Edward Blake Hutchinson was born on April 30th, 1841 in Maine to Richard Hutchinson and Mary Margaret Blake. He married Mary F. Hutchinson in 1872. Edward and Mary moved to Richmond, Indiana before moving to Indianapolis where he worked as a claim agent for the Pittsburgh, Cincinnati, Chicago, and St. Louis (Panhandle) Railway. They first lived at 733 N. Meridian Street before moving to 1702 N. Meridian Street in 1898. He died on May 22nd, 1917 in Indianapolis and is buried in Earlham Cemetery in Richmond, Indiana.
