HISTORICAL SKETCH

Elkhart, IN is located in Elkhart County 15 miles east of South Bend, IN. It is most known for being the "RV Capitol of the World" and for being the hub of concert band/orchestra and marching band instrument production. The city is home to several public history institutions, including the Midwest Museum of American Art, the National New York Central Railroad Museum, the RV/MH Hall of Fame and Museum, the "Time Was" Museum, and the Ruthmere Museum.

San Tress Draperies was formed in June 1967. It is a domestic for-profit corporation.

Pigs and cows have been harvested for their meat, milk and hides in America since the formation of the 13 colonies. Indiana is the 5th ranked state in hog and pig inventory. Indiana does not rank in cattle, beef, or milk industry sales.
