SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This is a typed transcript of a sermon given by Mrs. Emma Swisher, Minister of the Gospel on Sunday evening, December 8, 1919 at Frankfort, Indiana. Swisher bases her sermon on a passage from the 14 chapter of John, verses 2 and 3. She explains the passage comparing having faith in the Lord preparing a place for his people in the same way a bridegroom promises his bride that he will make a home for her and bring her there. She also speaks about being ready and prepared to meet the Savior when He comes. The sermon ends with a prayer and a poem called "The Flower Girl".
