#### **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Ezell Marrs (1901-1973) was born in Marion, Arkansas, but moved to Indianapolis at an early age. There, he was engaged in several types of occupations including a trucker and a laborer at a cement works. He later acquired several rental properties near the northwest side of Indianapolis and operated a grocery store from 1945-1965 at 1047 North West Street. Marrs later became an Associate Pastor at the Mount Paran Baptist Church. Ezell Marrs married Lela Rodgers in April 1926, and they had four children
