## **HISTORICAL SKETCH**

Newton County, Indiana, was formed in 1835. Its borders were redrawn to its current size in 1859. The Presbyterian Church is a Christian denomination and part of the reformed tradition within Protestantism. Presbyterianism beliefs emphasize the sovereignty of God, authority of scriptures, and necessity of faith. The church government consists of representative assemblies of members referred to as elders.
