BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Frank Maxheimer was born on 1 March 1872 to William Maxheimer and Margaret Umbaugh in Allen County, Indiana, where he lived all his life. He married Arminta "Minnie" Jane Earnst on 23 December 1896. The Maxheimers had two sons who both died by 1930. He worked as a farmer in Monroeville until 1912, and then worked as a hotel manager around 1920. By 1924 Frank and Arminta had moved to Fort Wayne where he worked as an assembler at the S. F. Bowser & Company gas pump plant. Frank Maxheimer died on 1 April 1934 in Fort Wayne, Allen County, Indiana.
