HISTORICAL SKETCH

Rendezvous was a term used during the Civil War meaning a location to gather men who were to be drafted or were about to enlist. The General Guard Draft Rendezvous, Indianapolis referred to a site in Indianapolis where veteran troops who were drafted and had served in other regiments awaited reassignment.
