SKETCH

Hamilton County purchased the former Harrell Hospital and Sanatorium at 148 N. Ninth St., Noblesville from Drs. Samuel and Madison Harrell in 1914. The county hospital remained in this downtown Noblesville location until 1951, when the county opened an 86-bed \$1-million facility at a site once known as Federal Hill. In 1952 the hospital was renamed Riverview Hospital. At the time of writing this guide, the hospital campus is now known as Riverview Health.
