## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Dr. Henry S. Wyman (1839–1897) was born in Jefferson County, New York. He later moved with his family to Madison County, Indiana. In September 1861, he enlisted in Company K of the 8th Indiana Regiment and was later promoted to corporal. In June 1864, he was discharged for an unlisted medical disability. Wyman later move to Seneca, Lenawee County, Michigan, where he married Mary A, Benjamin in 1878.
