BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

John Hutton, Jr. (1799–1877) was a native of Columbiana County, Ohio. In 1826, he married Rachel West (1803–40), the daughter of George and Elizabeth West of Columbiana County, in Carmel (Hamilton Co.), Indiana. Material in the collection indicates that Rachel was a teacher. John Hutton died in Kokomo, (Howard Co.), Indiana.

James W. Ream (fl. 1870–1918) enlisted in the 15th Indiana Regiment, Company F, in 1870

No information found in available resources for other family members mentioned in this collection. The genealogical material in folder 1 does provide birth, death, and marriage dates for some individuals.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection consists of papers (1817–1942) relating to the Hutton-Ream-West Family. Various family members appear to have lived in Hamilton and Howard counties, Indiana. The collection includes genealogical information; John and Rachel (West) Hutton’s marriage certificate; correspondence; poems; material relating to Rachel West’s occupation as a teacher; and a “Blue Ribbon Entertainment!” program, which includes J. W. Ream as a cast member.

Also included are two manuscript school notebooks (1824–25) used by Rachel West. They include arithmetic problems, poems, and dictations of lectures. The material within this collection is arranged chronologically within each folder.
