In 1926 Mrs. H.B. Burnet founded the Indiana Federation of Art Clubs (IFAC). The statewide organization was meant to encourage the appreciation and promotion of art in Indiana through the sponsorship of other art organizations, shows and tours. The club held its last meeting on 16 November 2002 after which it dissolved.
