SKETCH

Upon a Civil War soldier's discharge from the U.S. Army, he would receive a certificate identifying him, stating his reason for discharge, and entitling him to any remaining pay. Records were also produced by the U.S. Army Paymaster listing the pay and compensation for travel given to each soldier upon discharge.

Additional records were kept for officers on leave, detailing their expenses and the reimbursement they received from the U.S. Army Paymaster.
