## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Ira Weatherford (1883-1968) was born in Jefferson County, Indiana, near Madison where he helped his father farm and buy livestock. In August, 1907 Ira Weatherford married Ruby Buchanan (1889-1970), and in the fall of 1923 the couple moved to Anderson, Madison County, Indiana, where Ira continued to farm. The Weatherfords produced twelve children. In 1945 Weatherford and his family moved to Pendleton where he supplemented the family farm income from the early 1940s until 1952 by working for Delco Remy in Anderson. After he left Delco-Remy, Weatherford devoted his full attention to his farm, and to his passion of raising Black Angus cattle.

## **SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

Weatherford's ledger contains entries for the price of livestock, breeding records, and daily expenses for farm operation, 1910-1968. Added items include daily living entries and pay received for working at Delco Remy. The final entries appear to have been made by one of the Weatherford children.
