BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Isaac N. Morgan enlisted into the 37th Voluntary Indiana Regiment, Company "C," on October 28, 1861. There are no available records that state when he discharged from the Army, but on October 27, 1864, Morgan re-enlisted into the Army. The 37th Regiment was commissioned for 3 years, in which they were stationed in Ohio and Tennessee. There was not enough information available in this collection to provide further details of his life.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection contains one letter written by Isaac N. Morgan, of the 37th Voluntary Indiana Regiment at Camp Andrew Jackson in Tennessee, to an unnamed source on 6 March 1862. In the letter, Morgan discusses his company's march into Nashville, Tennessee and the high cost and scarcity of food in the region. He also discusses how his company's Chaplain was arrested for writing editorials that violated some of the articles of war. He seems to believe that the Chaplain will soon be released, and that many of the soldiers still looked favorably toward him.
