SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection consists of materials relating to James E. Sproule and pharmacists in Indianapolis, Indiana. Folder 1 contains assorted materials relating to James E. Sproule. These papers concern his involvement with the White Elephant bowling team of the Druggist Bowling League as well as handwritten notes and prescriptions for medicinal drugs. Folder 2 and 3 contain three notebooks with information relating to drugs, chemicals, and their properties. The 1875 notebook originally belonged to Charles Blodau (Blodow) before being passed on to Edward A. Allgire and then to James E. Sproule. Folder 3 also contains an illustrated Marshall's pocket almanac for the year 1905 that advertises pharmacist F.P. Pyke on the back.
