BIOGRAPHICAL / HISTORICAL SKETCH

Joan Lee Moore Harris was born on 21 May 1932 to John Pritchard Moore and Agnes Ione Lee Moore in Loogootee, Martin County, Indiana. She grew up in Evansville in Vanderburgh County, where she attended Culver School. She and her husband, Joseph “Joe” Graham Harris, Jr., were both among the 417 graduates constituting the Class of 1950 of Benjamin Bosse High School in Evansville. They attended many of their high school reunions, as documented in this collection.

Joe was born on 2 December 1931 to Joseph Graham Harris and Ella Louise Parsley Harris in Evansville. He attended Vogel School as a child. After graduating from Bosse High School, he worked for Bachman Buick Company and Indiana Insurance Company. He retired from Allstate Insurance Company after 27.5 years as a claims adjuster. He was president of the Adjusters Association, served as an assistant Scout leader, and enjoyed square dancing, golf, motorcycling, woodworking, and travel. He was a lifelong member of Oak Hill Church. He died 12 June 2018 in Evansville.

Joan worked for the Schroeder Wholesale Company and volunteered for many years with the Boys and Girls Club. She was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church, where she became its first woman cantor in 1985. She was a member of the Embroiderers Guild of America and served as its president. She was also a member of the Washington Square Knots Square Dancing Club. She enjoyed music, needlework, painting, cards, travel, and reading. She died on 15 September 2015 in Evansville.

Joan and Joe married in 1951. They had a daughter, Kathleen (Jobe), and two sons, Kim and John. They had eight grandchildren, and at the time of Joe’s death there were five great-grandchildren.

John M. Culver School was originally known as Campbell Street School. It was renamed in the 1930s to honor Principal John Morton Culver.

Benjamin Bosse High School was built in 1922 at the corner of Washington Avenue and Lodge Avenue in Evansville, one block east of U.S. Highway 41. It was built in the Collegiate Gothic architectural style and is in the Lincolnshire Historic District.

Camp Carson is a YMCA camp that was founded in 1940. It is located in Princeton, Gibson County, a little north of Evansville.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection consists of photographs of Joan Moore Harris and Joe Harris and their school friends in Evansville, Indiana. Most people have been identified. The collection is arranged into three series, as follows:

Series 1, Black-and-White Group Photos, Portraits, and Snapshots: This series is composed primarily of photographs collected by Joan Moore Harris as a child and into early adulthood. It includes two group photos from Culver School's May Day celebration in 1946 and 1948; snapshots of Joan and her Bosse High School friends; snapshots of Bosse faculty; snapshots of Bosse's senior picnic at Camp Carson in Princeton, Indiana; Bosse senior portraits (most from the class of 1950, some from the class of 1949); two Bosse faculty portraits; Joan Lee Moore's National Honor Society certificate; newspaper clipping announcing the engagement of Joan Moore and Joseph Harris; and snapshots of some of Joan's friends from high school with their young children (1954).

Series 2, Bosse High School's Class of 1950 Reunions: This series holds mostly color snapshots from reunions held beginning with the 40th in 1990 through the 61st in 2011. These were compiled by Joan and Joe Harris. There is a photo of all alumni attendees of the 45th reunion in 1995 with a separate chart and list for identification. There is also an eight-page list of 1950 alumni with addresses (ca. 1995). Also included is a booklet printed to commemorate the 50th reunion held in 2000, which contains as its centerfold a photo of all of that year's alumni attendees, with an identifying chart and list inserted as loose pages.

Series 3, Joe and Joan Harris, Their Home, & Miscellany: This series contains photos of Joan and Joe Harris at home, their home, Joe and Joan attending a wedding, and some lake views.

To search for photographs of individuals that appear in this collection, perform a key-word search by surname. Women are identified by their maiden name, married name, or both, so do a search for each name to find multiple photographs of the same person over the years included in this collection. First name identification varies, with the same person sometimes being identified as Marjorie/Marge/Margie, Bill/William, Betty/Bettye, Pat/Patricia, Bob/Robert, Jim/James, Joe/Joseph, etc.
