BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

John Michael Leffler, Sr. (1823-1889) was born in Perry County, Ohio, and moved to Warren, Huntington County, Indiana in 1850 where he worked as a house carpenter. He later is listed as living in several locations northeast Indiana including: Bluffton, Wells County, Harrison, Pulaski County, and Washington, Blackford County. Leffler was married to Caroline C. Leffler (1826-1874). After Caroline's death, he apparently moved in with his brother, Daniel, who lived in Washington, Blackford County.
